Holy Week Schedule

Holy Week remembers the events of the final week of Jesus' life, beginning with his triumphal entry into Jerusalem at the start of the Passover celebration, his final gathering and meal with his disciples on the night of the Passover meal, his crucifixion at the hands of the authorities on the next day, and culminates in his glorious resurrection on the third day.

April 10 - Palm/Passion Sunday Worship at 10 am: Join us as we celebrate Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem at the start of the Passover celebration. There will be a skit by our children and youth, with an assist by the congregation. The service will end with a reading of Luke's account of the Passion (suffering and death) of Jesus.

April 14 -Maundy Thursday Worship at 7 pm: We will gather for a special Worship service featuring hand washing, Communion, and prayer as we focus on the events of the last night that Jesus spent with his disciples before his arrest and crucifixion.

April 17 - Easter Worship at 10 am: We will gather to celebrate Christ's resurrection remembering how the women went to the tomb early that day but found it empty, and celebrate the return of the "Alleluia".
